QUEENSGATE IS A NEIGHBORHOOD OF BUSINESSES LOCATED JUST WEST OF DOWNTOWN CINCINNATI, WEDGED BETWEEN PRICE HILL, SOUTH FAIRMOUNT, THE CENTRAL DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT AND THE OHIO RIVER.

With easy access just off I-75, you can get to and from Queensgate from all major highways and roads near downtown, including I-71, I-74, I-275, I-471 and Routes 50 and 52.

Downtown Cincinnati and northern Kentucky are minutes from our doorsteps.

Three airports are within 16 miles of Queensgate: Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport – 14 miles; Lunken Airport – 8 miles; and Blue Ash Airport – 16 miles.

Union Terminal is being considered as the main Cincinnati station for the Ohio light-rail system, and local bus routes make getting to work convenient for Queensgate employees.
